

# The 7 Pillars of Grace

*“Grace, mercy, and peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord..”*

*2 Timothy 1:2*

Grace is the offspring of the redemptive work of Calvary. Grace is the free supply of divine goodness for spiritual elevation and empowerment in life. Grace is the divine influence and enablement to live an overcoming life in Christ. Grace grants us access for divine intervention to bring forth miracles in many life’s impossibilities.

- i) The priceless gift of His dear son.  
*“And of His fullness we have all received, and grace for grace.”* (John 1:16)  
When we received His son, (Ephesians 3:8,9), we have access to the unsearchable riches of Christ.
- ii) The magnificent gift of the Holy Spirit.  
*“...In whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise.”* (Ephesians 1:13)  
The Holy Spirit is also known as the Spirit of grace in Hebrew 10:29. He is the administrator of all grace on this earth.
- iii) The immense treasure of His word.  
*“by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises...”* (2 Peter 1:4)  
His word is the activating and quickening agent of His grace. (Mark 11:23; Zechariah 4:7)
- iv) The supply of providence to every sower.  
*“God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to make all grace abound toward you...”* (2 Corinthians 9:7b, 8a)  
Be the conduit of His grace by living a life of generosity towards His kingdom. (2 Corinthians 8: 3-7)
- v) The sweetness of thy lips  
*“Let your speech always be with grace, seasoned with salt, that you may know how you ought to answer each one.”* (Colossians 4:6)  
When our lives overflow with gratitude, our lips shall possess the fruit of gracefulness (Proverbs 16:21,24)
- vi) The glory of sincere humility.  
*“God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble.”* (James 4:6)

Exaltation comes to the soul that bow before His maker (1 Peter 5:6)

vii) The source of endless grace.

*“Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.”* (Hebrew 4:16)
