

Walking in the Truth

“Rather, let our lives lovingly express truth (in all things speaking truly, dealing truly, living truly).”

(Eph 4:15)

What is the vital sign you are filled with the Holy Spirit? According to John 16:13, those of us who are filled with the Spirit of Truth are to live a life of truth. So what then is truth? To live honestly and truly without any crafty intentions. Honesty is the best policy (testimony) of the kingdom living (James 3:17; 5:12; 2 Tim 2:15; 1 Jn 3:18; Col 3:9). The Bible clearly teaches, “lying lips are an abomination to the Lord, but those who act faithfully are His delights.” (Prov 12:22; 11:1) Remember His ways: God hates liars (Prov 6:16-19). Saints must conduct themselves honourably in harmony with a clear conscience (Heb 13:18; Acts 24:16).

Sometimes, Satan deceives us, but at other times we are self-deceived. In other words, we fabricate lives that we are comfortable with instead of facing life as it really is and taking the courage to deal with heart issues by the power and wisdom of the Holy Spirit.

The Holy Spirit confronts issues in our lives regularly and till He becomes a comforter of all your hidden and root issues, you never really live John 10:10. Cowards hide from the truth; Hypocrites run away from the truth. They are afraid to face it squarely. The Spirit of truth will then be a stranger to them (Prov 1:28-30).

If you are brave enough and wise enough to welcome the Spirit of Truth into every room in your house, you will be set free to live a true life of liberty in Christ. The veil and the shackles of religion will be permanently broken and the knowledge of the ways of God will be mightily made known to you. Then the knowledge of the Holy One will be also made known to you (Prov 9:10; 3:32; Jn 16:13-15).
