

Ten Most Significant Chapters

Have you ever considered what the most important chapters in the Bible are? There are altogether 1,189 chapters in the whole Bible. Twelve chapters would be the top 1% of chapters, so this list is actually the top 1 percent!

- #1 Genesis 1: Creation of man and their mandate to be fruitful, multiply and have dominion over the earth.
- #2 Genesis 3: Fall of man and promise of redemption through the seed of a woman
- #3 Exodus 20: Ten Commandments: moral ethics of kingdom
- #4 Isaiah 53: Christ, the ‘suffering servant’; Prophetic description of the life and death of Christ; Penal substitutionary atonement
- #5 John 1: Incarnation of Christ and His preexistence John the Baptist the forerunner of Christ
- #6 Matthew 28: Resurrection of Christ; Great commission to the church
- #7-9 Matthew 5-7: The beatitudes of wisdom and kingdom morality
- #10 Romans 8: The Spirit-life in Christ Jesus and ministry of Holy Spirit
- #11 1 Corinthians 13: The 16 characteristics love chapter
- #12 1 Corinthians 15: Gospel of resurrection of dead. The triumphant last Adam.

Other great chapters for meditation include Genesis 12; Psalms 1; 23; 51; 91; 119; Jeremiah 31 (The promises of the New Covenant); Matthew 6 (The model prayer); (The High Priest prayer of Jesus) Romans 3 & 6 the superior redemption; Romans 12 (Marks of a true Christian); Philippians 2 (Christ’s example of humility); 1 Thessalonian 4 (The rapture of Christ); Revelation 1-3 (The 7 churches); 1 Corinthian 3 (the last days refining judgement).
