

Praise Warfare

“Let the high praises of God be in their mouth, and a two-edged sword in their hand...”

Psalms 149:6

We have too many prayer warriors; it is time to raise praise warriors! You have prayed and fasted enough. Now discover the power in praise because when you are full of praises, you have more victories.

“The Lord upholds all who fall, and raises up all who are bowed down.”

Psalms 145:14

Praise brings God down from heaven. When you pray, God answers; but when you praise, He steps in, in all His glory, might, power and awesomeness. When God comes to our rescue, every devil gives way! (Ps 59:11,13)

“Through God we will do valiantly, for it is He who shall tread down our enemies.”

Psalms 60:12

Praise – warfare disarms every enemies and defeat every foe. Praise will grant you access into the peace zone because God’s presence automatically dispels evil. Every time David played on the instrument, the evil spirit departed from king Saul (1 Sam 16:23). Evil spirits cannot survive the presence of praise. The enemies cannot survive a praise-filled atmosphere, because it is God’s natural habitat (Ps 22:3)

The classic scriptural quotation for victory is Isaiah 54:17. But how does victory comes? Praise attracts the presence of God. When He steps in, the battle is over (Ps 68:2-4;7-8,14,21,32-35) What then is the essence of praise? A rejoicing heart (Ps 100:1-2). When you are joyless, you are helpless. When you are intoxicated with joy, it explodes in praises. When you filled your praises with faith-filled joy, the dynamic power of God will manifest in your situation (Ps 43:3-4). A winning Christian is a joyful praiser (Ps 89:15-17). Keep praising God, you will experience the realm of sweatless victory (2 Chron 20:21-24; 1 Cor 15:57).
