

Strength From Above

“The Lord is their strength, and He is the saving refuge of His anointed.”
(Ps 28:8)

The divine voice of God imparts spiritual strength and peace to His people (Ps 29:11). His strength draws nigh in the time of trouble when we put our trust in Him (Ps 37:39,40). His abiding presence is the source of unceasing strength (Ps 46:1,5). His great strength is the expression of divine help (Isa 41:10). “I will strengthen you and help you.” When divine strength comes, human weakness is no more a hindrance.

Divine impartation of supernatural strength is the practical expression of salvation (Ps 27:1). This heavenly strength overcomes cowardice and the haunting oppression of fears. Every opposition and foes cannot destabilize your trust in God (Ps 27:2-3). In reality, this supernatural strength is the strength of our devotions to God. It imparts the fervency of passion of seeking His face (Ps 27:4).

The joy of the Lord breeds holy strength (Neh 8:10; Ps 27:6). It lifts you above the torments of your enemies. You soar like eagles above the mountain of problem and woes. Your foes cannot locate you as you are hidden in His tabernacle (v.5). His Holy word strengthens your inner man (Ps 119:28). Your beloved pastor may have a great word, but he cannot teach you strength. Only God gives you strength, and it comes in answer to prayer (Ps 68:35). Divine strength gives acceleration and momentum to spiritual growth (Ps 71:16; 84:7). Finally, it inoculates you with boldness and courage (Ps 138:3; Ps 27:14). You will walk with the courage of a lion to face all foes. When God strengthens your heart, your faith will never quit in thy time of waiting before God for your answers.
