

The Functional Bliss of Faith

“Does he who supplies the Spirit to you and works miracles among you do so by works of the law, or by hearing with faith?”

Galatians 3:5

The supernatural realities of Christianity are affirmed by the conviction of faith. (Hebrews 11:1). Faith sees the unseen realms. Faith is the ‘sixth sense’ perception of the human spirit. Prayer offers unlimited possibilities and miraculous answers only if living faith is present. (Luke 11:8-10). Every time you utter a prayer, let it be filled with fervent faith-filled petition!(Luke 11:11).Hence, the degree of the outpouring and manifestation of the Holy Spirit in your life depends on the mighty operation of faith: ‘How much more will the heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him”(Luke 11:13)The success of the prayer exploits depends on the measure of our proactive faith in believing Him. How much more can you believe today? (Romans 8:32). In believing, you are receiving! (Matthew 21:22)
