

The Magnificent Power of His Word

“By the word of the Lord were the heavens made, their starry host by the breath of his mouth.”

(Ps 33:6, NIV)

Where is the greatest power in the whole universe? It is hidden and embedded within the pages of the Bible. The catalyst to unlock her energy is John 6:63. The word is the supreme creative power that spawned all things into existence (Jn 1:1-3). The greatness of God revolved around the awesome power of His word (Ps 147:4,5,15-18). The whole universe was the offspring of the living word: “*By faith, we understand that the universe was formed at God’s command...*” Heb 11:3, NIV). This ancient universe was also preserved in existence for billions of years by the invisible operation of God’s word: “*...sustaining all things by his powerful word...*” (Heb 1:3, NIV). The upholding power of His word will keep you strong in the midst of fiery trials and choking stresses of life (Ps 119:28, 116, 117; 1 Pet 1:5-8). Have you tapped on such dynamite power to resolve your pressing needs?

Then the officer said, “Sir, I am not worthy to have you in my home; (and it isn’t necessary for you to come). If you will only stand here and say, ‘*Be healed,*’ *my servant will get well!*” (Mt 8:8, Living Bible)

What will be your response if you know Jesus want to come to your home? You will be thrilled and overjoyed. However, this is not the case of the centurion. He shocked the disciples by saying he only needed His word. This caused Jesus to marvel at this man’s faith. This man knew something that most Christians have yet to discover: the power of His word. He believed that the spoken word is sufficient to bring healing to his servant. Truly, the rhema word alone can meet every needs (Prov 107:20). Lively and energetic confession is the “womb” where rhema is born (Lk 1:37, 46-55).

The word is the healing balm that resolves all your distresses (Dt 7:11-15). Life and health are inherent forces in the word (Prov 4:20-23). The original Hebrew word for “health” (*marpe*) is medicine. The word is medicine to your flesh. The word will invigorate your inner man (Ps 119:93). Apply diligently the 2 keys of Proverbs 4:20-21 and Psalm 119:43,48 : keep hearing (speaking) and keep remembering (meditation) the word in your mind and heart. When the word is internalized and “engraved” within, you will find life (strength) and health (vitality) to your whole being. Work the word and the word will work for you and in you.
