

## The Fifth Law of Spirituality

“But without faith, it is impossible to please him...”

(Heb 11:6)

Every miracle is the product of faith in God. The faith of Mark 11:22 is the mother of every blessings in Christ. This fifth law states that active faith brings forth the manifestation of God’s power. Faith is the gateway to the realm of the miraculous (Mk 10:27). Whoever possesses energizing faith become an overcomer and victor in life (1 Jn 5:4).

The gospel reveals a righteousness that lives by this rule: the just shall live by faith (Rom 1:17). The whole Christian life is a life of faith. Everything we do in the kingdom including every spiritual experience, we received it by faith. The testimonial reports of faith reveal that every exploit and accomplishment is wrought through faith (Heb 11:1-40).

True faith is never passive. It encompasses every active action. An account of a man of faith was Moses. Moses believed in the God of the Hebrews. He made a critical decision and gave up riches and fame of Egypt, abandoning the pleasures of sin (Heb 11:25-26). He became a mystic in the wilderness of Midian. God raised him up to be the deliverer of Israel, performing signs and wonders in Egypt. He saw the glory of God. The power of God raised the red sea and then later drowned the Egyptian chariots.

Some theologians coined the term: “Faith sees the invisible, believes the incredible, does the supernatural and receives the impossible.” Faith laughs at impossibilities, slain the Goliaths and shut the mouths of lions. Faith is not a feeling, but a conscious choice to believe continually and steadfastly upon what God had said. The acronym of faith: Forsaking all I trust Him. When you take a step of faith, the Holy Spirit leaps towards you. Faith is the law of attraction that attracts every Abrahamic blessings and favors to prosper your way.
