

The Supreme Asset

“Getting wisdom is the most important thing you can do! And with your wisdom develop common sense and good judgement.”

(Pr 4:7, Living Bible)

The greatest asset for advancement and upliftment in life lies in the possession of wisdom. (Pro 4:8,9,18). Wisdom brings precision and accuracy in decision-making. Wisdom is the ability to make sound application of knowledge. It is the last significant step in the thinking process, after which actions are executed.

The function of wisdom enabled one to make wise choices in life. Divine wisdom guarantees the flow of divine ideas, which is your guarantee for a unique exaltation in life. When you operate with heavenly ideas, you are bound to see heavenly – orchestrated harvest.

The atmosphere and climate of wisdom is the visitation and endowment of divine light. Heavenly light brings great enlightenment. It liberates the mind from narrow-thinking and illuminates the soul for development of creative mentality. The higher insights it offers navigates one from obstacles and humiliation and put one into a pathway of joyful triumphs.

Divine wisdom has an unlimited ability to deliver outstanding results. It was divine wisdom via guidance that generates a bumper harvest in the crisis season of famine (Gen 26:1-12). Divine wisdom brings distinction in life. Wisdom empowers Joseph to qualify him for the top political office in Egypt. Indeed, wisdom will make you the head and not the tail!
