

The Coming Spirit of Supplication

“And I will pour out upon the house of David and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem the Spirit of grace or unmerited favour and supplication.”

Zech 12:10

This precious verse vividly expresses the Holy Spirit as the Spirit of grace and supplication. In our lives, He reveals Himself as the Spirit of prayer. Each time we sense a desire to pray, it is the Holy Spirit imparting to us the desire for prayer. We may not realise how often the Holy Spirit is leading us to pray.
